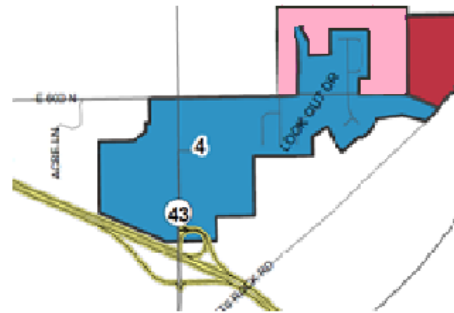
Dear Resident,

Town Council member Mike Bird will resign from his position as representative of Ward 4 at the end of December. Mike has served the town for 5 years, taking on the challenges of small town administration, volunteering for special tasks, and always completing assignments in a professional and timely manner. He will still be part of the community but we will miss his contributions to the council.

As this seat was filled by an Independent candidate, the Town Council will appoint an individual to replace Mr. Bird for the balance of the term through December 31, 2019. A Town Councilperson must be an American citizen, a resident of Ward 4, and a registered voter. The boundary of Ward 4 includes properties south of County Road 600 N, on Battlevue North and Warrior Drive, on the east side of Naschette between 600N and Puerto, and on 600N between Naschette and Battlevue.
